Monthly Cost is based on participation in a twelve-month payment plan that begins in May and continues for twelve consecutive months. The monthly cost is after the TDP is applied.

Tuition does not include specific items that are outside regular school operations, including college credit courses, optional testing, overnight field trips, mission trips, special events, school uniforms, Learning Enrichment, and supplies (including iPads for Secondary), and some cheerleading costs

Enrollment Information:

- 1. New Student Application: \$150**
- 2. New Student Testing: \$100**
- 3. Tuition Down Payment (TDP): \$350** - Due by March 1st for current students and upon acceptance for new students
- 4. Harvest Fund: \$500**- One-time new student investment in HCA development
- 5. Payment Options:**
There are two ways to pay tuition:
 - a. Payment in full - A 3% discount will be applied for payment in full by June 1st
 - b. Twelve-month payment plan through FACTS beginning in May

All financial arrangements must be made by June 1st. Students enrolling after June 1st must have financial arrangements in place before attending classes.

You may also qualify for one of the following scholarships:

- 1. Multiple Child Discount**
 - a. Second Child - \$800
 - b. Third Child- \$1,000
 - c. Fourth Child- \$1,500
- 2. Military and Active First Responder** - 10% annual scholarship for financial dependents of current active duty or Reserve/National Guard Service Members and Active First Responders.
- 3. FBC Keller Membership** - 10% annual scholarship for active members.
- 4. Pastoral Discount** - 35% scholarship available to Pastors working full time in ministry.

*Generally, the highest scholarship applies and is not combined.
